Inframe Gallery Framing App Guide


This guide explains how to use the Inframe framing app.

Getting Started

- 1. Access the app by visiting https://inframe.euframing.studio/ or by using the links on the Inframe website.
- 2. Log in using your email address. If you are a new user, you will need to create a password.

Creating Your Design

3. To begin a new design, click the "Select & Upload" button and choose your image, designs can be created without using an image(refer to **Figure 1**).



4. Input the desired image size and utilize the cropping tool if necessary (refer to **Figure 2**).



5. Select one of the pre-defined templates. You can modify these options on the subsequent page.

Customizing Your Frame

- 6. Mounts (refer to Figure 3):
 - Option 1: Choose the mount board color and decide if you want a single, double, or triple mount.
 - o Option 2: Define the border width.
 - Option 3: Specify the external mount size.
 - If you are having an image printed, and you require a margin of paper around it, you can use the Subj. Spacing box.
- 7. **Mouldings**: Enter a moulding code or select from the available options. Moulding samples can be provided upon request.
- 8. **Options**: In the final section, you can select choices for glass, backing, mounting, and paper type for printing.

Finalizing Your Order

- To add any specific instructions for your order, click the orange notes box.
- 10. Once satisfied with your design, click"Update" and then "Done" to proceed to your basket.
- 11. In the basket, you can review details and adjust item quantities.
- 12. If you have multiple images that require the same size and options, use the "copy" button to duplicate an item. You can then edit the duplicated item to change the image (refer to **Figure 4** in the original PDF).
- 13. To create an entirely new item, click the "Create another item" box at the bottom of the page.
- 14. After confirming your order, choose your preferred shipping method or opt for in-store collection, then click the green button to submit your order.
